**Responsibilities/Accountabilities:**

The successful candidate will primarily be responsible for designing and executing completions and workovers that contribute to the high growth profile of the company. This position will entail working on oil and gas wells including new completions on vertical, deviated and horizontal wells in addition to workovers on vertical and horizontal wells that often have technical challenges. The completion and workover process will include design execution and evaluation.

- Design and coordinate completion programs from AFE preparation to completion of field operations. This will require the candidate to generate the cost estimate, raise the AFE, coordinate services, take daily calls and invoice coding/approval.
- Interact extensively with surface land department, geologists, exploitation engineers and service companies to generate the completion programs.
- Manage the company's completion, recompletion and well maintenance operations in a safe, professional and cost effective manner, ensuring complete adherence to safety, regulatory compliance, cost control and competitive bid procedures.

- Coordinate the utilization of internal resources as well as external consulting staff required to achieve ongoing completion, workover, and well servicing operations.
