The successful candidate will coordinate construction activity in the NE BC and Grande Prairie area of Alberta. This position is based in the Calgary office, but will require field travel to support the projects and field inspection personnel.

- Provide budgetary and AFE quality cost estimates for production facilities and pipelines.
- Liaise with exploitation engineers and field operations personnel to establish project design.
- Pipeline route selection.

- Coordinate EUB/OGC applications with contract engineering companies.
- Procure equipment and materials.
- Schedule and coordinate project construction activities.
- Supervise field inspection services.
- Monitor construction progress and initiate corrective action as required.
- Work with operations personnel in the commissioning and startup of facilities.
- Project cost control and forecasting.
- Review documentation to ensure regulatory compliance and quality control.
- Ensure Company environmental, safety standards, and local regulations are followed by all construction and inspection personnel.
