Responsibilities/Accountabilities:

This position will be located in the Calgary Office with the majority of the work being based in Alberta. This role will primarily be responsible for, but not limited to the following:

- program, schedule and monitor all completion and workover activity for the company; organize equipment and supervision of jobs;

- responsible for dealing with regulatory agencies to keep informed of changing regulations and ensure all work is done according to current regulations. Must be up to date on all relevant government regulations in Alberta and British Columbia.
- keep abreast of new technology and implement where appropriate;

- work closely with production engineers and geologists to ensure everyone is in agreement with planned operations;
- communicate with partners to ensure all working interest owners are committed to planned operations;
- review and approve invoices.

Skills/Qualifications:
