Responsibilities/Accountabilities:

The Supervisor, Asset Integrity is accountable for pipeline and pressure equipment integrity management programs for operated facilities and non-operated facilities, as requested. In addition, the candidate will also be responsible for providing technical support to Operations, Maintenance and Facility engineering groups.

- Develop, implement and maintain the Pressure Equipment Integrity Management (PEIM) program to all operating districts across Western Canada and United States.
- Conduct jurisdictional / internal company audits.
- Provide point of contact with jurisdictional authorities on pressure equipment and piping regulatory issues.
- Perform all inspection activities and repairs of pressure piping, vessels and tanks.
- Ensure Integrity Management database is effective and meets the requirements of the various Provincial/State jurisdictions.
- Develop repair procedures for pressure equipment.

- Provide training, execution and maintenance of the “Management of Change” process.
- Work closely with Facility engineering group to provide technical support on projects.
- Work with Calgary based engineers and field based operations teams to provide budgets for yearly inspection plans.
- Provide coaching and mentoring to members of the engineering teams.

Skills/Qualifications:

- Registered Professional Engineer or Engineering Technologist.
- Minimum 20 years of related integrity management experience in the Canadian upstream oil and gas industry is required.
- API 510 or National Board and Alberta / Saskatchewan pressure vessel inspector certifications are required.
- Strong knowledge in pipeline and pressure equipment design and construction codes is required.
- Working knowledge in inspection techniques, materials, welding and mechanical engineering is required.
- Experience in developing and managing an Integrity Management Plan is required.
- Working knowledge of Non-Destructive Testing methods; certification in any relevant discipline would be an asset.
- Experience with the development and management of Inspection and Corrosion Control programs along with knowledge in failure investigation and root cause analysis would be an asset.
- Past experience with pipeline and equipment degradation mechanisms and applicable inspection detection methods would be an asset.
- Familiarity with pressure vessel fitness for service assessment.
- Working knowledge of provincial pipeline & pressure equipment Acts and Regulations.
