**Responsibilities/Accountabilities:**

The Senior Project Manager is accountable for management of pipeline projects from commercial development to implementation and operation. This role ensures project activities are carried out in compliance with all regulatory, technical, environmental, and safety requirements, in consideration of stakeholder input and in accordance with schedule, budget, and commercial economics. In addition, this position provides pipeline project management support to Business Development for development of prospective projects.

- Manage consultants, contractors, and direct project team members in a manner that results in projects incurring reasonable costs, meeting schedule targets, and achieving commercial goals.
- Resourcing of external and internal subject matter experts to achieve project goals.
- Scrutinize scope changes and change orders to ensure they are valid, justified and reasonable cost impact.
- Development and monitor project budgets and schedules, and validate any deviations to plan.

- Monitor project activities to within budget and schedule and take appropriate remedial action if necessary.
- Monitor procurement/expediting of materials and equipment in accordance with our client's standards.
- Regular reporting to our client's Enterprise Project Committee.
- Ensures that pipeline facilities are constructed and maintained in compliance with regulatory requirements and specifications and operating practices.
- Consult with appropriate team members and stakeholders to establish practical and mutually agreed upon design criteria and facility performance.

- Maintain knowledge of industry practices and technological advances related to pipeline operations.
- Meet with operations representatives on a periodic basis to better understand their support requirements.
- Provide cost estimates for project development screening activities.
- Development of Design Basis Memorandums, provide technical input into development concepts.
- Manage engineering studies to determine project costs, schedules and execution strategies.
- Provide assessment of appropriate technology for development concepts.
- Ensure that incidents are reported to Management in a concise and timely manner.
- Ensure construction contracts reflect our client's Health, Safety and Environmental programs, including performance measurement indicators.
- Ensure that contractors have appropriate safety manuals and procedures to complete the work safely.
- Ensure that workplace inspections are done on a regular basis in order to monitor contractor safety performance on the job in accordance with the approved safety manual.
- Ensure that construction is consistent with the environmental plans and procedures.
- Employ methods and designs which reduce or negate environmental impact.
- Communicate clearly and openly with a diverse group of stakeholders and act autonomously to assess and resolve situations.
- Develop mutually beneficial partnerships with key stakeholders.
- Participate in industry related associations to keep abreast of changes in legislation and regulations and facilitate liaison with all levels of government.
