Responsibilities/Accountabilities:

Reporting to the Manager, Pipeline Integrity, this Calgary based position will provide technical guidance and field support to our client's Pipeline Integrity Group in their implementation and execution of pipeline integrity programs and projects. Additionally, the position will provide engineering support for day-to-day, routine engineering and operations activities requiring the Pipeline Integrity Group's participation. As part of this role some travel and field work to support inspection, monitoring and mitigation activities will be necessary, averaging one week per every 4 weeks out of the office on an annual basis.
